I. Capernaum v.40

Translation — "And when Jesus returned the people received Him because they had been expecting Him." v.40

II. Jairus vv.41-42

Translation — "And behold a man named Jairus who was ruler of the synagogue came and fell down at the feet of Jesus and began to beg Him to come to his house." v.41

Translation — "Because he had an only daughter about twelve years old, and she was dying. But as He was going the people crowded about Him." v.42

III. Interruption vv.43-48

Translation — "A woman in the crowd had suffered for twelve years with constant bleeding, and she could find no cure." v.43

Translation — "Coming up behind Jesus, she touched the fringe of his robe. Immediately, the bleeding stopped." v.44

Translation — "And Jesus said, 'Who touched me?' (Literally, The one who is touching me is who) But as everyone denied it Peter said, 'Master the crowds are thronging and pressing upon you from all sides." v.45

Translation — "But Jesus said, Someone has touched me, because I am aware that power has gone from me." v.46

Translation — "Therefore the woman, when she realized that she was not hidden came trembling and fell down before Him and declared before all the people the reason why she touched Him and how she was healed immediately." v.47

Translation — "And He said to her, 'Daughter, your faith has saved you. Go in peace." v.48

IV. Death and Life vv.49-56

Translation — "As He was speaking someone came from (the house) of the ruler of the synagogue saying, 'Your daughter is dead. Do not trouble the Teacher any longer." v.49

Translation — "But when Jesus heard it He answered him, 'Try not to be afraid. Only believe one more time and she will be saved." v.50

Translation — "And when He came into the house He did not allow to enter in with Him anyone except Peter, and John, and James and the father of the little girl and her mother." v.51

Translation — "And everyone was weeping and beating himself because of her. But He said, 'Try to stop crying, because she is not dead, but she is sleeping." v.52

Translation — "But they began to laugh at Him, because they knew that she was dead." v.53

Translation — "But when He had taken her hand, He called, saying, 'Maid, arise." v.54

Translation — "Therefore her spirit returned, and she stood up immediately, and He ordered that something be given to her to eat." v.55

Translation — "Therefore her parents were beside themselves. But He began to order them to tell no one about that which had been done." v.56
