

Luke 9:10-17

Feed Them

I. Apostles v.10

Translation - “And when they returned the Apostles gave Him a full account of what they had accomplished. And He took them with Him and withdrew privately unto a city called Bethsaida.” v.10

II. Crowds vv.11-12

Translation - “But when the multitudes learned of it they began to follow Him; so He received them and began to speak to them about the Kingdom of God, and those who had need of healing He cured.” v.11

Translation - “But the daylight began to fade; so the twelve came and said to Him, ‘Send the crowd away, in order that when they have gone into the surrounding villages and fields they may bed down and find food, because we are here in a deserted spot.’” v.12

III. Feed Them vv.13-17

Translation - “But He said to them, ‘Give them something to eat yourselves.’ But they said, ‘There are here available to us not more than five loaves and two fish, unless we go and buy food for all these people.’” v.13

Luke 9:10-17

Feed Them

Translation - “...for there were about five thousand men present. But He said to His disciples, ‘Seat them in groups of about fifty each.’” v.14

Translation - “Therefore they did as He said and began to tell everyone to sit down.” v.15

Translation - “And He took the five loaves and the two fish, looked up to heaven and blessed them and began to break and give to the disciples to serve to the crowd.” v.16

Translation - “And they ate and everyone was filled and there was picked up of the fragments that remained to them twelve baskets full.” v.17
