#### 1. REVIEW

- A. THE 3 pieces of **THE ARMOR of GOD** THAT we ARE to "<u>HAVE</u>" (WEAR) <u>ALL</u>
  THE TIME ARE:
- B. <u>Ephesians 6:12-15</u> (NASB) For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places. Therefore, take up the full armor of God, so that you will be able to resist in the evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm. Stand firm therefore, HAVING GIRDED YOUR LOINS WITH TRUTH, and HAVING PUT ON THE BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS, and having shod YOUR FEET WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE;
  - 1. The **BELT of TRUTH**
  - 2. The BREASTPLATE of RIGHTEOUSNESS
  - 3. The SHOES of PEACE
- C. THE 3 pieces of **THE ARMOR of GOD** THAT we ARE to "<u>TAKE UP</u>" (HAVE AT HAND) in "The Evil Day" ARE:
- D. <u>Ephesians 6:16-17</u> (NASB) in addition to all, taking up the shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil *one*. And take THE HELMET OF SALVATION, and (take) the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.
  - 1. The SHIELD of FAITH
  - 2. The HELMENT of SALVATION
  - 3. The SWORD of the SPIRIT
- E. **EXAMPLE:** During the game a **softball** or **baseball player** MUST **ALWAYS WEAR their UNIFORM... "HAVE"** 
  - 1. Wearing the uniform HELPS **PREVENT CONFUSION**.
  - 2. **DURING** the game, **WHILE WEARING THEIR UNIFORM**, there are times when players "TAKE UP" a GLOVE or a BAT… "HAVE AT HAND"
- F. DISCUSS
- G. WHAT IS FAITH?
  - 1. The simplest **DEFINITION** OF <u>FAITH</u> IS THAT <u>FAITH</u> IS <u>ACTING</u> AS IF <u>GOD</u> <u>IS TELLING THE TRUTH</u>.
    - a. <u>FAITH</u> is **DIRECTLY TIED** to an <u>ACTION</u> done in <u>RESPONSE</u> TO A <u>REVEALED TRUTH</u>.
  - 2. FAITH is a FUNCTION of the MIND that SHOWS UP in the FEET.

- 3. If we were half as educated in the <u>WORD OF GOD</u> as we are in the <u>WORLD</u>, we would be further along in living a **VICTORIOUS LIFE**.
- 4. When the <u>OBJECT</u> of our <u>FAITH</u> is <u>GODS REVEALED TRUTH</u> (HIS WORD), even the tiniest amount can move mountains.
  - a. <u>NOTE</u>: <u>FAITH</u> does <u>NOT</u> move mountains... <u>FAITH IN WHAT GOD'S</u>

    <u>WORD HAS TO SAY ABOUT OUR CIRCUMSTANCES</u> IS WHAT <u>MOVES</u>

    <u>MOUNTAINS</u>.
- 5. We <u>DO NOT NEED MORE FAITH</u>... all we need was given at **SALVATION**.
  - a. We <u>NEED</u> to <u>KNOW MORE TRUTH</u>... because <u>FAITH</u> is the <u>POINT of</u> ACCESS, NOT the SOURCE of POWER.
- 2. Sometimes, we **BELIEVE**, OR WE ARE <u>TEMPTED</u> <u>TO BELIEVE</u> ("did God really say?"), that we <u>NEED</u> TO <u>DO</u> GOOD <u>WORKS</u> in order to <u>ACCESS</u> what God has in store for us in His **GRACE**.

#### A. "TEMPTATION"

- James 1:13-15 (NASB) Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am being tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, and He Himself does not tempt anyone. But each one is tempted when he is carried away and enticed by his own lust. Then when lust has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and when sin is accomplished, it brings forth death.
- B. BUT our WORKS actually EXHIBIT OUR FAITH.
- C. They **PROVE the EXISTENCE** of our FAITH.
  - 1. WORKS DO NOT ACCESS GRACE because once we attach WORKS to GRACE, it's NO LONGER GRACE because GRACE "IS THE GIFT OF GOD".
    - a. <u>James 2:18</u> (NASB) But someone may well say, "You have faith and I have works; show me your faith without the works, and I will show you my faith <u>by my</u> works."
    - b. Romans 11:6 (NASB) But if it is by grace, it is no longer on the basis of works, otherwise grace is no longer grace.
      - 1) **GRACE** is **THE FREE GIFT of GOD**
      - 2) <u>Ephesians 2:8-9</u> (NASB) For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is <u>the gift of God; not as a result of works</u>, so that no one may boast.
  - 2. WORKS EXHIBIT FAITH, and FAITH ACCESSES GRACE
- 3. HEBREWS 11 is frequently referred to as the "Hall of Faith".
  - A. In this chapter we read about men and women who were **APPROVED** by **GOD** because of their **FAITH**.
  - B. Their **ACTIONS REVEALED** their **FAITH**.

- 1. "By faith Abel offered..."
- 2. "By faith Noah...prepared..."
- 3. "By faith Abraham...obeyed..."
- 4. "By faith Isaac blessed..."
- 5. "By faith Rahab...welcomed..."
- 6. **BY FAITH**, each one **TOOK <u>ACTION</u>**... reached down and **PICKED UP** the **SHIELD** instead of letting it sit leaning up against a wall.
- 7. <u>Hebrews 11:6</u> (NASB) And without <u>faith</u> it is impossible to please *Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him.
- C. To <u>LIVE</u> BY FAITH means that FAITH becomes our regular WAY of THINKING, DOING, and BEING.
  - 1. FAITH means MORE than merely ACKNOWLEDGING that the SHIELD IS THERE, and that it's an effective form of protection.
    - a. FAITH MEANS <u>GRABBING</u> THE <u>SHIELD</u> (ACTION) and <u>USING IT</u> (ACTION)!
  - 2. The **ONLY WAY** we can **HAVE THAT KIND OF FAITH** is to **RECOGNIZE** that **FAITH is <u>NOT A FEELING</u>** or a DISCUSSION.
    - a. <u>FAITH IS AN ACTION</u> taken based on the **AUTHORITY** of Somebody who knows what He's talking about.
      - 1) FAITH is ONLY AS VALUABLE as the OBJECT to which it is LINKED.
        - i. <u>FAITH NEEDS AN OBJECT WORTHY</u> of it.
    - b. Our <u>VIEW</u> of <u>GOD</u> and <u>HIS WORD</u> HOW <u>BIG</u> WE <u>BELIEVE</u> GOD IS <u>WILL DETERMINE THE SIZE OF OUR FAITH</u>.
      - 1) "GOD, I'VE GOT A MIGHTY BIG PROBLEM" -vs- "PROBLEM, IVE GOT A MIGHTY BIG GOD"!
  - 3. <u>FAITH</u> is a <u>CONVICTION</u> ABOUT THE <u>REALITY</u> OF <u>WHAT WE CANNOT</u> SEE.
    - a. <u>FAITH</u> is <u>BELIEVING</u> when there is <u>NO EMPIRICAL</u> (VERIFIABLE by OBSERVATION or EXPERIENCE) <u>EVIDENCE</u>.
    - b. <u>Hebrews 11:1</u> (NASB) Now <u>faith</u> is the <u>assurance of things hoped for</u>, the conviction of things not seen.
    - c. 2 Corinthians 5:7 (NASB) for we walk by faith, not by sight—
      - 1) In other words, IF WE CAN <u>SEE IT</u> WE ARE <u>NOT EXERCISING</u> FAITH.
      - 2) FAITH is our POSITIVE RESPONSE TO GOD'S WORD.
      - 3) **EXAMPLE**: Duncan Holmes

- i. He WALKS BY FAITH (in more ways than one) ALL the time!
- 4. EVERYONE CAN BELIEVE IN SOMETHING WE CAN SEE.
  - a. God is talking about a **FAITH** that spots and grabs something out of the **UNSEEN** realm and brings it down into the **PHYSICAL** realm AND **USES IT IN SPIRITUAL WARFARE**.
  - b. <u>2 Corinthians 10:3-5</u> (NASB) For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh, for the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses. We are destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the knowledge of God, and we are taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ,
- D. If Jesus Christ was able to <u>OVERCOME ALL THE SIN</u> of the entire world on the CROSS, He can certainly SEE US THROUGH <u>ANY CIRCUMSTANCE</u> we are in right now.
  - 1. <u>OUR PART</u> is to <u>BELIEVE</u> WHAT GOD'S WORD SAYS that Jesus can enable us to overcome <u>IN</u> OUR CIRCUMSTANCES, and to <u>ACT</u> on that BELIEF.
- E. The **SHIELD OF FAITH** has been given to us to **PROTECT** us from the **DECEPTIVE PRACTICES OF THE DEVIL**.
